

New team leading activities

Whether it's a rambunctious game of Farkle or cheering on a horse derby, activities abound at Jacobson Memorial Hospital Care Center (JMHCC).

Two new faces are now leading the activities at JMHCC, including Activities Director Brittney Molitor and Activities Assistant Dana Solley. The two plan everything from lively games to quiet one-onone visits to put smiles on the residents' faces.



Molitor has worked at JMHCC for two years as a certified nursing assistant (CNA). She started in September 2021, dividing her time between serving as the assistant activities aide and a CNA before becoming a full-time CNA.

Originally from Nevada, she previously worked at the nursing home in Mott in housekeeping before becoming a CNA eight years ago.
